### **KEEPING UP WITH KAPTAIN KUSH**

Knaus Berry Farm is officially OPEN! Locals should know, but for those out-of-towners, this is a MUST DO Miami experience. People will be heading down in hungry herds to the lower part of Dade County and get some cinnamon rolls and a strawberry milkshake at Knaus Berry Farm. Be warned, there is always a wait unless you tell them your friends with Kaptain Kush; it's at least worth a shot!

But getting to the importance of this local tradition, Knaus Berry Farm was founded in 1956 as a roadside stand, where Ray and Russell Knaus sold berries. The brothers soon expanded their inventory to include pies, a variety of freshly baked bread and other baked goods when a fruit broker told Ray's wife, Barbara, that her cookies were "good enough to sell". Today the farm is still ran by Ray and Barbara's children and their families and Knaus Berry Farm has expanded to sell fruit shakes, local vegetables and coffee. It also offers U-pick strawberries and tomatoes later in the season.

The vibe is still very much the same as it was in the 1960s, Blocher says. "We want Knaus Berry Farm to be Knaus Berry Farm, always."
